

Cullum offers an Mechanical Drafting Apprenticeship

Cullum offers the opportunity to get paid to learn as a youth apprentice. Youth apprentices receive paid on-the-job training along with job related education. The Charleston Metro Chamber of Commerce helps ensure funding to cover the costs of tuition, books and material for the apprenticeship-related college courses.

Upon completion of the apprenticeship program

Students will receive a high school diploma (if not already granted); college credit from TTC free of charge; a completion certificate for coursework that may be applied to an associate degree; national credentials from the U.S. Department of Labor; 6,000 hours of work experience*; marketable skills for life.

Eligibility

To be eligible for the Mechanical Drafting youth apprenticeship, a student must be; a rising junior, senior or graduating senior; at least 16 years of age; legally able to work in the U.S.; achieve qualifying ACCUPLACER Placement Test scores; maintain a GPA of 2.00, willing and able to commit to the full program; demonstrate academic readiness and responsibility; have reliable transportation to work and to school.

Mechanical drafters are able to read and interpret drawings and specifications. A drafter can take design input and replicate a visual representation of plumbing and HVAC systems and details using software such as Revit or AutoCAD.

Drafters are detailed oriented, need to have near vision (be able to see details up close), creative visualization, and mathematical reasoning and aptitudes.

*Average completion time of the Mechanical Drafting Apprenticeship is 3 years.

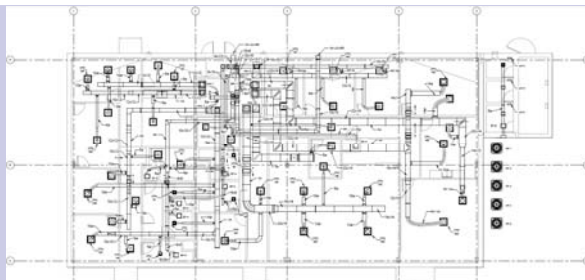
