



**Cullum offers a Sheet Metal Apprenticeship**

Cullum’s apprenticeship has two parts: on-the-job training and job related education. Upon completion you’ll receive a certificate from the Department of Labor.

**On-The-Job Training**

The apprenticeship program requires you to complete 8,000 hours of on-the-job training. A year consists of 2,000 hours, you’ll have completed the required hours at the conclusion of the fourth year. (if you are working full time 40 hour weeks)

**Job Related Education**

During the term of your Apprenticeship, you’re required to complete approximately 144 credit hours of job related education for each year of the Apprenticeship. We have partnered with NCCER for the job related education. The curriculum is divided into many different modules that build on each other as you progress through the program. Each module includes tests and quizzes to verify your comprehension of the material. We’ll track your progress to ensure you are completing the required courses.

**Eligibility**

To be eligible for the apprenticeship, you must be; at least 16 years of age; legally able to work in the U.S.; willing and able to commit to the full program; demonstrate academic readiness and responsibility; have reliable transportation to work.
